

RESOLUTION No. 16-195

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE AWARD OF INVITATION TO BID #2016-20, "NW 66 STREET ROADWAY CONSTRUCTION" TO FLORIDA ENGINEERING AND DEVELOPMENT CORP; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT, SUBJECT TO APPROVAL AS TO FORM AND LEGAL SUFFICIENCY BY THE CITY ATTORNEY, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,333,051.39 FOR THE PROVISION OF ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS ON NW 66 STREET BETWEEN NW 97 AVENUE AND NW 102 AVENUE, AND TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS IN FURTHERANCE HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in response to Invitation to Bid #2016-20 (the "ITB") for "NW 66 Street Roadway Construction from NW 97 Avenue to NW 102 Avenue" (the "Project"), the City received six (6) bids by the July 28, 2016 deadline with all six (6) companies meeting the required criteria; and

WHEREAS, upon review of bids received, staff determined that Florida Engineering & Development Corp. ("Contractor") was the lowest most responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, a copy of "Contractor's Bid Submittal," which includes the Construction Contract, ITB #2016-20 Inventory, and Bid Tabulation, is all attached as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, staff has recommended that the City Council authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with contractor for the construction of Project, in a not to exceed amount of \$1,333,051.39, which includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen conditions, and to expend budgeted funds in furtherance hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Award. The ITB is hereby awarded to Florida Engineering And Development Corp. in accordance with Contractor's Bid Submittal. This award in and of itself does not confer any contractual rights.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and enter into an agreement between the City and Contractor for the Project, subject to approval by the City Attorney as to form and legal sufficiency, in the amount of \$1,333,051.39, which includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen conditions, and to expend budgeted funds in furtherance hereof.

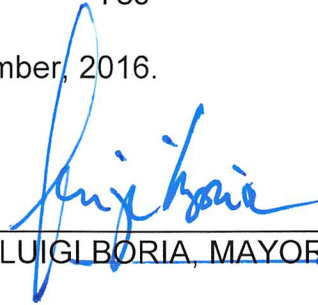
Section 3. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
