

RESOLUTION No. 16-204

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-322 OF THE CITY OF DORAL CODE OF ORDINANCES, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF TWO UTILITY VEHICLES FOR THE USE OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$27,325.47; VIA STATE OF FLORIDA CONTRACT NO. 25100000-16-1 BETWEEN THE STATE OF FLORIDA AND WESCO TURF INC; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACTUAL DOCUMENTS AND TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS IN FURTHERANCE HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral Parks and Recreation Department has budgeted funds for the purchase of two (2) utility vehicles to place one (1) Toro Workman at Doral Glades Park and replace one (1) Toro Sand Pro at Doral Meadow Park; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sec. 2-322 of the City Code, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Wesco Turf, Inc. for the purchase of two (2) utility vehicles for the use of the Parks & Recreation Department in an amount not to exceed \$27,325.47; and

WHEREAS, staff further requests that the City Council recognize that this agreement is based on the existing agreement between Wesco Turf, Inc. and the State of Florida which was competitively entered into a manner similar to that set forth in Chapter 2, Article V, of the City Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval of Services. The purchase of two (2) utility vehicles shall not exceed \$27,325.47.

Section 3. Authorization to Procure Services. The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and with Wesco Turf, Inc. for the purchase of two (2) utility vehicles.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such action as may be necessary to implement the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilmember Cabrera who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Vice Mayor Fraga and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


