



Recycling Ordinance

ORDINANCE #2014-28

Sec 32-101. – Recycling program and separation of recyclable materials from solid waste stream required for multifamily residences of four dwelling units or more; owner/association liability; recycling contractors' assistance.

As of July 1, 2015, every Multifamily Residential Establishment shall provide a recycling program pursuant to this section or a city-approved modified recycling program pursuant to section 32-104. The Recycling Customer shall be liable for the failure to provide a recycling program or a modified recycling program approved by the City. Further, recycling contractors shall assist and provide written notice to the Director of the City's Public Works Department in identifying multifamily residences subject to this article which do not have a recycling program or, in the alternative, which have allowed a recycling program to lapse or expire.
